Dear Residential Living residents,

Many of you have asked about receiving the COVID-19 vaccine. As we have shared during the broadcasts, we are actively working to understand when the vaccine might be available for you. We are also looking into ways that we can partner with a pharmacy to bring the vaccine to campus. At this point, we continue to explore all avenues.

In the meantime, I wanted to share some information that we received from one of your fellow residents. They were able to get an appointment to receive the vaccine at Lehigh Valley Hospital (LVH). I made a call to LVH to find out more details. I was told that they are offering the vaccine to individuals 75 and older. They cannot guarantee an appointment or vaccination as they are using leftover doses from other priority groups. The person I talked with said that if someone were to call, they could expect an appointment sometime during the first week of February.

I was able to talk to someone almost immediately by using the first number. I tried the second number several times and was told to call back later as they were experiencing a high number of calls. We cannot guarantee that this option will be successful. However, we are committed to sharing information as we receive it. Our desire is for everyone that is interested in becoming vaccinated to be able to do so as soon as possible.

Please know we will also continue to explore ways of providing the vaccine on campus.
